FINANCE & FUNDRAISING

Greetings to the Members and Friends of UUCJ,

The following is an update from the treasurers. The treasurers of UUCJ are taking this opportunity to give you a brief update on some of the financial matters of the church. As of April 9, 2025, the mortgage balance is \$57,907.61.

The March Split the Plate Donations is the International Conference of UU Women (ICUUW). A check for \$600.49 was sent on March 31, 2025.

Other checks that were sent in March for previous split the plate recipients and other donations were as follows: Joliet Pride Network (\$279.50); NHBW, Inc. Joliet Chapter (\$105.00); World Central Kitchen, Inc (CA Wildfire Collection - \$636.00); The Spanish Center (Food Pantry - \$200.00); Queen on Apostles (Food Pantry - \$200.00).

The Split the Plate recipient for April is Arab American Family Service.

The church has three CDs. The total invested in CDs is \$94,306.48.

The Board has decided to take some of the money from our CDs and invest the money in Credit Union that is located in the Chicagoland area. This investment is intended to help out this new Credit Union

There were no capital expenses for March.
